WHAT IS ALEXA?

The Echo, known commonly as Alexa was developed by Amazon and was first released in 2014. The Amazon Echo product line is a family of devices that connect to Alexa and can be controlled by an individual's voice. Alexa is an intelligent, cloud-based voice service. Alexa devices let vou use your voice to control Echo devices by speaking commands. Echo devices connect to Alexa to play music, make calls, control your smart home, and provides information, news, and weather. Users must have Wi-Fi, a smartphone or tablet to set up devices and there are no monthly fees.






