Alice earned her BSP in Parks, Recreation and Conservation, and a MAEd in Adult Education from East Carolina University. Alice's career began with the Greenville Recreation and Parks Department in 1973 as the Coordinator of Programs for Exceptional Children and Adults. From 1978-2006 Alice served as the Director of Pitt County Community Schools and Recreation, and currently serve as the Recreation Projects Coordinator (part time) for Pitt County Government. Alice's professional career has been marked by involvement in developing many new programs including: the first year-round programs for special populations for the City of Greenville; the first Greenville-Pitt County Special Olympics Program; the Community Schools and Recreation Program for Pitt County; and the North Carolina Senior Games Program. In addition to many "first", Alice has worked for over 40 years in developing recreation programs, implementing joint use agreements, building school parks, developing the Pitt County District Park, developing strong collaborative partnerships, developing the first Staff Wellness Program for Pitt County Schools, and advocating for policy and environmental change that supports healthy eating and physical activity.
