PROGRAM DETAILS

May 29–July 30, 2025

- ✓ Program supports \$1,500 supplies, \$6,500 student stipend, \$2,000 housing.
- ✓ Students matched with mentors according to research interests.
- ✓ Mentors actively work with students on lab/field/computer-based research.
- ✓ Students participate in weekly professional development activities and research poster symposium at end of program.
- ✓ Students work with faculty from **Environmental Health, Public Health, Biology, and Health Education and Promotion** at East Carolina University.

Students recruited from minority serving institutions across NC, including Fayetteville State University, UNC Pembroke, Elizabeth City State University, NC Central University, NC Agricultural and Technical State University, Chowan University, and others.
